### Fee Due Dates

Annual school fees are billed in Term 1, payable over the first three terms by the following due dates:

- 15 February 2012
- 15 May 2012
- 15 August 2012

### Resource and Technology Fees

The fees are used to cover the following expenses:

- subject charges for English, Maths, Science and other subjects
- Music resources, Art equipment and materials, Home Economics equipment and materials (excluding fabric), PE equipment and facilities
- Technology/Computing resources and facilities, internet access, email
- printing and photocopying up to a limit, Library and audio/video resources, textbook hire, student ID
- teaching aids, faculty consumables, English, Maths and Science competition fees
- sports carnivals, part-subsidy for retreats and RE Days
- School Magazine, locker, CEO Student Levy, Copyright Levy, School Care Accident Policy, Ambulance Cover
- maintenance of school plant and facilities
- debt servicing of capital projects.

### Student Activities Fee

The Student Activities Fee is compulsory and covers the small charges for retreats, excursions, bus hire and payments to visiting performers and speakers.

### Year 8 Camp and Year 12 Retreat

The Year 8 Camp and Year 12 Retreat are compulsory hence no refund will be given for non-attendance as bookings and preparatory work are based on the year level student numbers.

### Building Fund

Donation to the Mary MacKillop College Building Fund is voluntary, tax-deductible and used entirely for the yearly maintenance and upkeep of College plant and facilities.

### Vocational Education and Training (VET) Fees

Students are responsible for the payment of VET fees when enrolled in VET courses. VET fees start from \$300. The College subsidises 50% of VET fees up to a maximum of \$300 per year. Students are required to pay the fees prior to the commencement of their courses. Refer to the VET 2012 Enrolment Process available from the VET Coordinator.

### Application Fee and Enrolment Fee

Application fee of \$55.00 is payable upon lodgement of application. Enrolment fee of \$150.00 is payable upon acceptance of offer of placement. Application fee and enrolment fee are non-refundable.

### Family Discount

Families who wish to avail of the Family discount should submit the form - Application for Family Discount 2012 no later than 30 November 2011. For new enrolments during 2012, please apply as soon as possible. Your account will be adjusted once the information you have provided has been verified.

### School Card Discount

Families who wish to avail of the School Card discount should submit the School Card Application Form 2012 preferably before 9 March 2012. The discount will be passed on to you once you are confirmed eligible by DECS. Whilst waiting for the decision from DECS, you may pay the school fees less the expected School Card discount. For School Card discount of students on scholarship, please contact the Director of Business and Finance. For School Card discount of families on split bills, you are entitled to 50% of the School Card discount.

### Early Payment Discount

Early payment discount will be available if total annual school fees (including building fund) are paid by 15 February 2012.

### Fee Remission for Families in Financial Difficulties

Families experiencing financial difficulties, including families whose only income is Centrelink payments (excluding FTB A and B), should set up an appointment with the Director of Business and Finance to discuss financial circumstances.

Please submit the form - Application for Fee Remission 2012. Application will not be assessed without proof of income - Centrelink documents, pay advice and tax return. Fee remission applies to current year only and is provided on a case-by-case basis. Families who are provided fee remission are encouraged to pay by direct debit starting from 15 February 2012.

### Payment Arrangements

We accept payment in cash, cheque, credit cards (MasterCard or Visa), direct debit, EFT and Bpay.

Families who are unable to pay in three terms should organise before 15 February 2012 a payment plan to pay equal instalments - 10 months (using credit card or direct debit) or 20 fortnights/40 weeks (using direct debit). Credit card instalments will be processed on the 15th day of the month. Direct debit instalments will be processed on the date indicated on the direct debit form.

### Withdrawal from College

Families are required to give the Principal one term's notice of withdrawal of a student, otherwise, 25% annual school fees will be charged. Payment of fees is still required where a student is absent from school for any length of time, eg overseas trip, holiday, sickness.

### Overdue Accounts

The College reserves the right to pass overdue accounts to debt collection agencies for collection. If this occurs, families are responsible for the payment of the collection costs as per parents/guardians declaration in the 'Application for Enrolment' and 'Enrolment Contract'.
